History: Date built: soon after 1826
Edward Salt Sr. a native of Berkshire England
came to America, at an early date, settling with
his Irish bride in Berkeley Co. Va. where
(3) three daughters & (2) two sons were born.
1790 came to Crab Orchard Ky & in 1796 to
Bullskin (Ohio) where he had charge of a ferry
and where he died in 1812. His son John
Jr.

purchased a large tract of land in Tate
township where he resided until his death
in 1859. He was a ^{extensive} trader on the river
(Ohio) loading flat boats at Pt. Pleasant
and made in all (52) fifty-two trips to New
Orleans returning on foot (13) thirteen times
coming through the perilous Indian coun-
try with the proceeds of his voyages. Father
of L. H. Salt - Gustavus Salt - Daniel Salt
Welshire and Francis Marion. The other
son of Edm. Sr. was Edw. Jr. also a resident
of Tate Twp. where he died in 1870. He was
